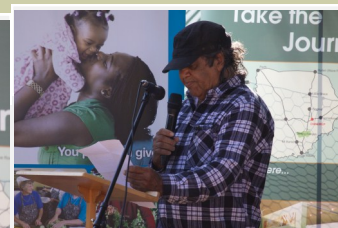




Yongerknow's 10 Year Anniversary A Resounding Success
