MALLEEFOWL MONITORING IS BACK "Bushwalking with a purpose"

Every year, the National Malleefowl Recovery Team head out bush to investigate known mounds to them and monitor any activity that has been going on.

This free event is described by NMRT as "...bushwalking in rural and sometimes remote parts of Western Australia. A suitable level of physical fitness and appropriate clothing and footwear is a pre-requisite for joining these monitoring events"

It's a fantastic opportunity to learn more about the monitoring process and get up close and personal to our beloved Malleefowl's habitat in the wild. The public dates and the call for volunteers are as follows;

“What a lonely place it would be to have a world without a wildflower!”


